

ASIMO heads to Germany for AMI 2012

Germany, June 03, 2012 - ASIMO traveled to Leipzig, Germany this week to attend AMI 2012 (Auto Mobil International), the country's only international motor show. Held in Leipziger Messe, a stunning exhibition hall designed by British architect Ian Ritchie, the show is expected to attract over 300,000 visitors.

ASIMO will be performing nearly 40 shows and will be joined on the Honda stand by the all new Civic, the Jazz Si, a CR-V prototype, and the zero-emission, hydrogen fuel cell electric car, the FCX Clarity.

ASIMO has already made an impression at the show, meeting VIPs and senior Honda associates during the press day.
